It's that time of the year again, when India is celebrating Republic Day and looking back at the history of one of India's greatest military operations. On 15 August, 1962, the Indian Army launched Operation Blue Star, in which it had the intention to enter the capital city of then-capital of Pakistan, Srinagar, and take control of the state. Before the operation, Pakistan's President Ayub Khan had warned India that any such operation would be met with "retaliation at the time and place of our choice", and he announced that the army and the air force would "reserve the right of taking the appropriate action without prior warning". And the world, led by the United States, began to get very worried. Indo-Pak War of 1965 The Pakistan Air Force (PAF) was given a green signal by Pakistan to start an air war against India. And they did. Pakistan sent several fighter jets to attack India's air bases, including the PAF base in Pathankot. However, India's air force was well-prepared. The PAF did not only lose a number of its fighter jets but also an Ilyushin Il-62M airliner that was on a civilian mission. The Indo-Pak air war lasted from 31 December 1965 to 18 February 1966. The PAF eventually lost nine jets in the air war, including an Il-12 Mk.1 airliner, and of the 10 pilots who were lost, eight were women and the last one was a girl. The PAF lost 20 aircraft in the air war, including one Il-14 and one Il-20. Of the 40 aircraft lost in total, 31 were damaged and nine were completely destroyed. But, of the nine destroyed, three were destroyed by Pakistan and six by India. One of the most controversial battles of the war was the IAF's attack on the PAF headquarters at Miramshah, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan. This battle, that would later become known as "Miramshah attack", was launched on the orders of the Indian prime minister, Lal Bahadur Shastri. It was a retaliation to the PAF's attack on Pathankot. In the aftermath of this attack, the Indian government had placed Pakistan under curfew, and since there was no control over Pakistan's territory 82157476af
